4. Juries

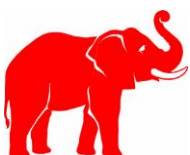

7. Official Dress Code for the Team Photographs

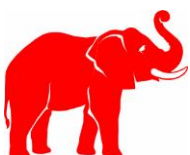
- **Provincial Colours** to be worn by Provincial Team Members for **official photographs**.

9. Safety and Dress Code During the Competition

As per CTSASA Competition regulations. **Smart/casual is the code** - no torn clothing, no cut-offs, no sleeveless shirts, no military wear, **no open-toed shoes/sandals, no flip-flops**. All footwear to be closed in shoes.

Clay Target Shooting is a prestigious sport, hence the need to abide by the dress code and in particular for the publication of promotional videos and photographs as well as respect for our sponsors.

- **No open shoes or sandals - all footwear to be closed in.**
- **All shorts/skirts to be no more than 5cm above the knee.**
- **All competitors to wear eye protection and ear protection.**
- **All FITASC Sporting competitors to have the 25cm line on their shooting jacket/shirt**

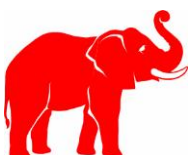
All umpires will be briefed to ensure that the above is complied with. Anyone NOT complying with the above will be deemed absent until the dress code is rectified.

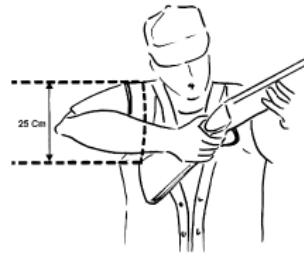
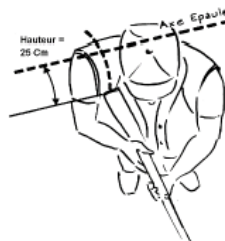

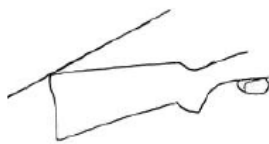

25 cm = 9,85 inches

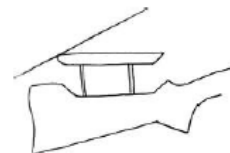
Height: 25 cm Shoulder axis
