




















Competition Regulations

- 1. Shooting will start promptly at the specified time. The first squad must be on the ranges and ready to shoot 15 minutes before the allotted time. Succeeding squads to be on the range 10 minutes before preceding squads have completed their round. Any shooter absent when his/her squad is due to shoot will forfeit the complete round of targets. An appeal to the appropriate jury may be made to consider the reason for the absence. An appeal fee of R250 must be paid with the appeal and the appeal must be in writing.
- 2. **Scoring**: If you are required to score, the following are applicable rules:

Trench: two shooters from the previous squad to score for the next. Visible scoreboard on Trench to be used.

Trap & Skeet: one shooter from previous squad to score for the next.

Sporting: The umpire may score the round or may nominate a person from within the squad to score.

After you have completed your round and it is your turn to score, you are not permitted to leave the range. A penalty loss of one target will apply if you leave the range for any reason before you have completed your scoring duty or if you fail to score when it is your turn to do so.

All shooters must sign for their scores before leaving the range.

All shooters in all disciplines must check their score <u>before leaving the range</u> <u>and at appropriate times during the round</u>. Any dispute regarding scores cannot be reported to the jury unless a protest is made according to the discipline rules and before leaving the range.

- 3. Umpires will be provided where possible on all ranges. Competitors will be required to score and will score in rotation in squad position order. In Universal Trench, shooters 1 and 3, then 2 and 4, then 3 and 6 to score. In the Sporting discipline the umpire may nominate his scorers from within the squad. Refusing to score is not permitted. Any shooter refusing to score will be penalized with the loss of 3 targets per refusal.
- 4. The first Sporting Squads should also report to the ranges 15 minutes before the allotted time. Sporting shooters to proceed immediately to the next range as per the shooting schedule.

Competition Regulations

- 5. The 10 second 'ready' rule in FITASC Universal Trench and the 15 second rule in FITASC Sporting will be strictly applied.
- Applicable rules: CTSASA Competition Regulations, ATA, FITASC, NSSA Skeet. At all times, where there is a CTSASA over-riding bye-law, this will take precedence over the individual discipline rules.
- Shooters may not change squads and squads may not alter the squad shooting sequence. Changes can only be made by the Shoot Organiser (Sarah Kalell).
- All score pads must be signed by each individual in the squad, the scorers and the
 umpire. Only justifiable queries to be referred to the Jury via the Shoot Organiser
 (Sarah Kalell). Pads to be returned to the office by the scorer at the end of the
 round.
- Equipment traps, scramblers etc. must not be tampered with. In the event of a breakdown contact the shoot convenor.
- 10. Reloaded/Self-Loaded Ammunition

Any person shooting reloaded/self-loaded ammunition must be aware that the Jury at any event is entitled to obtain samples of reloaded ammunition for testing.

- 11. Please assist the organisers by adhering to these rules and so facilitate the smooth running of this event.
- 12. Where a dispute occurs and the rules are not explicit enough to provide for a clear cut decision, the final decision rests with the individual discipline jury as elected for this event.
- 13. Dress code: the dress code as per the CTSASA Competition Regulations will apply. Eye and ear protection is mandatory. No open shoes or sandals. No camouflage, no shorts shorter than 5cm above the knee, no ripped or torn clothing "Smart/Casual" is the standard. All clothing must be tidy and clean.
- 14. No cell phones to be used for any purpose whilst shooting a round of clays. No smoking or 'vaping' (e-cigarettes) on the shooting ranges.

A Brief History of the Chairman's Cup

The Chairman's Cup in its present form is now in its 40th presentation, having commenced in 1984. Prior to this, the event had been held in a different format and had been mostly sponsored by Datsun, followed by Swartklip Products. For most of the recent past, the CTSASA has been sponsoring the event with the exception of the ammunition.

In 1984, an overall High Gun Trophy and trophies for each individual discipline were presented by the late Dr Alec Kalell, Chairman of the CPSA (now CTSASA). The competition was now called "The Chairman's Cup" and its

timing at the end of November concludes the shooting calendar of the CTSASA. The Annual Awards Ceremony for all the year's awards is held on the Friday evening prior to the start of the Chairman's Cup. This is a prestigious evening where National Protea Colours, Association Merit Colours and other awards are presented to the winners and high achievers of the year. 

MANDATORY

SHOTGUN SAFETY RULES

1 Treat every gun as if it is loaded and with the utmost respect at all times.



When carrying a gun it should be open and empty at all times. Pump action and semi-automatic guns should be carried with bolts back, chambers and magazines empty, barrels pointing upward, breech forward



3Avoid alcohol and horseplay when in possession of a gun.



4 When using a gun you should have on your person only those cartridges which are of the correct gauge and chamber length to match the gun.



5All guns should be:-

- a) "nitro-proofed"
- (b) "in proof"
- (c) in safe and sound condition to shoot.



6 DO NOT point or fire your gun at anything other than a clay target (i.e. do not point or fire your gun at any other inanimate or animate object). Failure to observe this rule will lead to disqualification and explusion from the ground.

BEHAVIOUR ON FIRING POINT

Before loading your gun with one or two cartridges, check that the barrels are free from obstruction and that they are pointing up the range.



8 Keep the muzzles pointing up the range at all times until you have opened and emptied your gun. Then (and only then) you may turn around and walk off the firing point.



GUN MALFUNCTION - Keep the muzzles pointing up the range until the malfunction is identified and corrected. (If upon firing the gun the cartridge makes an unusual report, then before reloading you should check the barrels are free from obstruction).




